3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Human Resources to collaborate with 4 certain interest groups to prepare certain educational materials; specifying the 5 contents and formats of the educational materials; requiring the educational 6 materials to be updated periodically and distributed in consultation with certain 7 interest groups; requiring the educational materials to be provided at no cost to 8 certain organizations; requiring a certain brochure to be available on the 9 Department's Web site and supplemented by certain additional information; 10 and generally relating to adoption awareness and the provision of materials 11 related to adoption.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 SUBTITLE 3C. ADOPTION AWARENESS PROGRAM.

- 1 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLABORATE WITH INTEREST GROUPS
 2 THAT SPECIALIZE IN ADOPTION RELATED ISSUES TO PREPARE EDUCATIONAL
 3 MATERIALS ABOUT CREATING AN ADOPTION PLAN FOR AN INFANT.
- 4 (B) THE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS SHALL PROVIDE PROSPECTIVE 5 BIRTH MOTHERS AND BIRTH FATHERS INFORMATION ABOUT THE ADOPTION 6 PROCESS.
- 7 (C) THE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS SHALL:
- 8 (1) BE DESIGNED TO INFORM BIRTH MOTHERS AND BIRTH 9 FATHERS ABOUT ADOPTION AS AN OPTION FOR AN UNINTENDED PREGNANCY;
- 10 (2) INCLUDE A BROCHURE, A POSTER, AND INTERNET-BASED 11 INFORMATION; AND
- 12 (3) BE UPDATED PERIODICALLY AND DISTRIBUTED IN 13 CONSULTATION WITH INTEREST GROUPS THAT SPECIALIZE IN ADOPTION 14 RELATED ISSUES.
- 15 (D) THE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS SHALL BE SUPPLIED AT NO COST TO
 16 ANY MEDICAL OR COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INTERESTED IN PROVIDING
 17 INFORMATION ABOUT ADOPTION.
- 18 (E) THE BROCHURE SHALL BE AVAILABLE IN ELECTRONIC FORM ON
 19 THE DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE AND SUPPLEMENTED ON THE WEB SITE BY
 20 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO BIRTH MOTHERS
 21 AND BIRTH FATHERS FACING AN UNINTENDED PREGNANCY WHO ARE SEEKING
 22 INFORMATION ABOUT CREATING AN ADOPTION PLAN FOR THEIR INFANT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
