AN ACT concerning
Maryland Legal Services Corporation Funding – Abandoned Property Funds
FOR the purpose of altering the distributee of certain abandoned property funds that the Comptroller is required to distribute; repealing certain provisions of law requiring the Governor to appropriate a certain amount in certain budgets each year to the Maryland Legal Services Corporation Fund; repealing certain provisions of law authorizing the Governor to transfer a certain amount to the Fund from a certain portion of abandoned property funds; altering a certain source of money in the Fund; and generally relating to Maryland Legal Services Corporation funding.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Commercial Law Section 17–317(a)
