CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's College of Maryland – Tuition Freeze and DeSousa–Brent Scholars Completion Grant

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Maryland from increasing the undergraduate resident student tuition rates in 6 certain academic years; requiring the Governor to appropriate a certain amount 7 to St. Mary's College of Maryland from a certain fund in certain fiscal years; requiring a certain calculation for a certain fiscal year to include certain funds; 8 9 establishing a DeSousa–Brent Scholars Completion Grant; stating the purpose 10 of a certain grant; prohibiting a certain appropriation from being included in a 11 certain calculation for certain fiscal years except in certain circumstances; 12 requiring a certain report by a certain date; defining certain terms; and 13generally relating to St. Mary's College of Maryland.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND THAT ARE 11 REQUIRED OF ALL UNDERGRADUATE RESIDENT STUDENTS BY THE INSTITUTION 12 AS A CONDITION OF ENROLLMENT REGARDLESS OF THE STUDENT'S DEGREE 13 PROGRAM, FIELD OF STUDY, OR SELECTED COURSES.

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(II) "TUITION" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

15 **1.** FEES THAT ARE REQUIRED OF ALL 16 UNDERGRADUATE RESIDENT STUDENTS BY THE INSTITUTION AS A CONDITION 17 OF ENROLLMENT REGARDLESS OF THE STUDENT'S DEGREE PROGRAM, FIELD OF 18 STUDY, OR SELECTED COURSES;

192. FEES DEDICATED TO SUPPORT AUXILIARY20ENTERPRISES AND OTHER SELF-FUNDED ACTIVITIES OF THE INSTITUTION; OR

A FEE REQUIRED ONLY FOR ENROLLMENT IN A
 SPECIFIC DEGREE PROGRAM, FIELD OF STUDY, OR COURSE WHEN THAT FEE IS
 NOT REQUIRED OF UNDERGRADUATE RESIDENT STUDENTS AT THE INSTITUTION
 FOR ENROLLMENT IN OTHER DEGREE PROGRAMS, FIELDS OF STUDY, OR
 COURSES.

(B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEARS BEGINNING IN THE FALL OF 2013 THROUGH AND THE FALL OF
28 2017 2014, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY NOT APPROVE AND MAY NOT IMPOSE
AN INCREASE IN THE TUITION CHARGED FOR AN ACADEMIC YEAR TO A
RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT AT THE INSTITUTION OVER THE AMOUNT
CHARGED FOR TUITION AT THE INSTITUTION IN THE PRECEDING ACADEMIC

MARY'S COLLEGE OF $\mathbf{2}$ 3 MARYLAND \$800.000 PLUS: 4 (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, THE PRIOR YEAR'S APPROPRIATION FROM THE FUND MADE UNDER THIS SECTION MULTIPLIED BY THE IMPLICIT $\mathbf{5}$ 6 PRICE DEFLATOR FOR STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT USED UNDER § 14-405 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 GENERAL FUND GRANT: 7 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016. THE PRIOR YEAR'S APPROPRIATION 8 (2) FROM THE FUND MADE UNDER THIS SECTION MULTIPLIED BY THE IMPLICIT 9 PRICE DEFLATOR FOR STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT USED UNDER § 14-405 10 11 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 GENERAL FUND GRANT; FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017. 3 (B) THERE IS A DESOUSA-BRENT SCHOLARS COMPLETION GRANT TO 4 ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND.

5 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE GRANT IS TO INCREASE THE RETENTION AND 6 GRADUATION RATES OF DESOUSA-BRENT SCHOLARS AT ST. MARY'S COLLEGE 7 OF MARYLAND.

8 (D) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2014 THROUGH 2019, THE GOVERNOR SHALL 9 APPROPRIATE THE FOLLOWING GRANT AMOUNTS FROM THE FUND TO ST. 10 MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND:

11 **(1)** \$300,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 2014;

12 (2) \$550,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 2015; AND

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(3) \$800,000 IN EACH OF FISCAL YEARS 2016 THROUGH 2019.

14 (E) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2015 THROUGH 2020, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN 15 SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR'S APPROPRIATION 16 FROM THE FUND MADE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE 17 CALCULATION UNDER § 14–405 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

18 (F) THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 APPROPRIATION FROM THE FUND SHALL BE 19 INCLUDED IN THE CALCULATION UNDER § 14–405 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR THE 20 FISCAL YEAR 2020 GENERAL FUND GRANT APPROPRIATION IF:

21(1) THE FIRST- TO SECOND-YEAR RETENTION RATE FOR THE22FALL 2015 COHORT OF THE DESOUSA-BRENT SCHOLARS IS AT LEAST 88%;

23(2)THE FIRST- TO THIRD-YEAR RETENTION RATE FOR THE FALL242015 COHORT OF THE DESOUSA-BRENT SCHOLARS IS AT LEAST 79%; AND

25(3) THE FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION RATE FOR THE FALL 201526COHORT OF THE DESOUSA-BRENT SCHOLARS IS AT LEAST 70%.

(G) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR ST. MARY'S COLLEGE
 OF MARYLAND SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THE
 RETENTION AND GRADUATION RATES OF DESOUSA–BRENT SCHOLARS.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2013.
