1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public Information Act - Electronic Mail Address - Database and Disclosure

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a unit or an instrumentality of the State or of a 3 4 political subdivision to maintain certain electronic mail addresses in a certain 5 database; specifying that the database is confidential and not a public record; 6 prohibiting the database from being disclosed in its entirety except under 7 certain circumstances; establishing the circumstances under which a unit or an 8 instrumentality is required and is authorized to disclose the database in its 9 entirety; providing that an individual electronic mail address maintained in a database may be disclosed under certain circumstances; providing for the 10 construction of this Act; and generally relating to the treatment of electronic 11 12 mail addresses under the Public Information Act.

- 7 (2) THE DATABASE IN WHICH A UNIT OR AN INSTRUMENTALITY 8 OF THE STATE OR OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION MAINTAINS ELECTRONIC MAIL 9 ADDRESSES UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- 10 (I) IS CONFIDENTIAL;
- 11 (II) IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD; AND
- 12 (III) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, MAY NOT BE DISCLOSED IN ITS ENTIRETY.
- 14 (C) A UNIT OR AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE OR OF A POLITICAL
 15 SUBDIVISION THAT MAINTAINS ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESSES IN A DATABASE
 16 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:
- 17 (1) SHALL DISCLOSE THE DATABASE IN ITS ENTIRETY IN 18 RESPONSE TO AN ORDER ISSUED BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION; 19 AND
- 20 (2) MAY DISCLOSE THE DATABASE IN ITS ENTIRETY ON A FINDING 21 BY THE UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY THAT THE DISCLOSURE OF THE DATABASE 22 IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC SAFETY OR TO ASSIST IN THE 23 INVESTIGATION OR PROSECUTION OF A CRIME.
- 24 (D) AN INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS THAT IS MAINTAINED
 25 IN A DATABASE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY BE DISCLOSED
 26 INDIVIDUALLY IF THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDED THE ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS
 27 TO THE UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE OR OF A POLITICAL
 28 SUBDIVISION:
- 29 (1) IN THE COURSE OF AN EXISTING BUSINESS OR CONTRACTUAL 30 RELATIONSHIP WITH THE UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY; OR
- 31 (2) IN THE COURSE OF SEEKING TO ESTABLISH A BUSINESS OR 32 CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY,

- 1 INCLUDING IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR AN INVITATION TO
- 2 BID FROM THE UNIT OR INSTRUMENTALITY.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 2013.
