- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19Article Public Safety
- 20 7-303.

(a) (1) This section applies only to Allegany County, Carroll County, Cecil
County, Dorchester County, Frederick County, Harford County, Kent County,
Somerset County, Wicomico County, and Worcester County.

1 (2) Except as modified by this section, the provisions of § 7–302 of this 2 subtitle apply to this section.

3 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the 4 commanding officer may designate 12 members of a fire company to be appointed as 5 deputy sheriffs.

6 (2) In Cecil County AND HARFORD COUNTY, the commanding officer 7 may designate 20 members of a fire company to be appointed as deputy sheriffs.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
