A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Appointment of Fire Company Members as Deputy Sheriffs**
3 **– Number**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of members of a fire company in Harford
5 County that a commanding officer may designate to be appointed by the sheriff
6 as deputy sheriffs; and generally relating to deputy sheriffs in Harford County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Public Safety**

20 7–303.

21 (a) (1) This section applies only to Allegany County, Carroll County, Cecil
22 County, Dorchester County, Frederick County, Harford County, Kent County,
23 Somerset County, Wicomico County, and Worcester County.

1 (2) Except as modified by this section, the provisions of § 7–302 of this
2 subtitle apply to this section.

3 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the
4 commanding officer may designate 12 members of a fire company to be appointed as
5 deputy sheriffs.

6 (2) In Cecil County **AND HARFORD COUNTY**, the commanding officer
7 may designate 20 members of a fire company to be appointed as deputy sheriffs.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2013.
