- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) The Department annually shall publish maps and coordinates of oyster 17 sanctuaries, closed oyster harvest reserve areas, and areas closed to shellfish harvest 18 by the Department of the Environment.

19 (b) (1) The Department shall provide the publications required under 20 this section to each tidal fish licensee who pays the oyster surcharges required under 21 § 4–701(e) of this title.

22 (2) Before a person may catch oysters under a tidal fish license that 23 has an oyster authorization and for which the oyster surcharges have been paid, the

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person shall certify to the Department on a form the Department prescribes that the
person received the publications required under this section.

3 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, THE 4 DEPARTMENT MAY NOT DESIGNATE A NEW OYSTER SANCTUARY IN STATE 5 WATERS BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2018.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of 8 September 30, 2018, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act 9 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
