3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State from imposing or levying a 4 vehicle-miles-traveled tax or certain other similar fees, tolls, or taxes; 5 prohibiting the State from requiring the installation of a device in or on a 6 privately owned vehicle or using an odometer reading to facilitate the reporting 7 of the number of vehicle miles traveled for a certain purpose; and generally 8 relating to prohibited acts related to a measurement of vehicle miles traveled.
