20 **(B)** NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE 21 ADMINISTRATION SHALL REQUIRE AN OPIOID MAINTENANCE THERAPY 22 PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO HAVE STANDARDS THAT ARE 23 EQUIVALENT TO A CERTIFIED ASAM LEVEL OF TREATMENT IN THE 24 FOLLOWING AREAS:
