(Senate Bill 269)

AN ACT concerning

State Retirement and Pension System - Correction of Errors in Benefits

FOR the purpose of altering the conditions under which the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System is required to correct an error that results in a retiree or beneficiary receiving a benefit that differs from the benefit the retiree or beneficiary is entitled to receive; and generally relating to administering benefits from the State Retirement and Pension System.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

21-113.

- (a) Except as provided in § 29–402 of this article, if, because of an error [in the records of the several systems], a retiree or beneficiary receives a benefit that differs from the benefit the retiree or beneficiary is entitled to receive, the Board of Trustees shall:
 - (1) correct the error; and
- (2) to the extent practicable, adjust the payment to the retiree or beneficiary to provide the actuarial equivalent to which the retiree or beneficiary is correctly entitled.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
