# Chapter 347

(House Bill 34)

#### AN ACT concerning

## State Government - Commemorative <del>Day</del> <u>Month</u> - German-American Heritage <del>Day</del> Month

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day <u>month</u> as German–American Heritage <u>Day Month</u>; requiring the proclamation to urge certain organizations to observe the day <u>month</u> with certain activities; and generally relating to German–American Heritage <u>Day Month</u>.

### BY adding to

Article – State Government

Section 13–411

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article - State Government

#### 13-411.

- (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT GERMAN AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM OCTOBER & AS GERMAN-AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY MONTH.
- (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE GERMAN-AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY MONTH PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
