10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)						

The Mount Pleasant Community Development Corporation (MPCDC) is a powerful partner within the northeast Baltimore Community working to improve the quality of community life of the residents. The purpose of the MPCDC is to meet the needs of the community through outreach and supportive services that will be provided through the Mount Pleasant Family Life Center (FLC). The FLC will be a community-based activity center for children, youth, elderly and families that will provide educational, recreational, health, and social service programs to enhance and enrich the quality of life in the community in a safe, nurturing, and structured environment which support the holistic development of body, mind and spirit. The FLC will provide a community-based state of the art meeting and multi-purpose facility. In addition numerous supportive services will be provided to address the needs of the community including: a food pantry, substance abuse counseling, family counseling, crisis pregnancy counseling, mentoring programs and health services.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The purpose of this project is for renovation of HVAC systems and public restrooms of the Mount Pleasant Family Life Center. The FLC will provide community-based state of the art meeting and multi-purpose facility. In addition, the FLC will house five (5) dedicated components including: a Business and Learning Center that will provide computer stations to increase community access, literacy and comfort in the use of technology, as well as, provide after-school programs and homework support; a Women's Resource Center that will provide case management, counseling, crisis pregnancy services, educational and parenting programs, health services, and community forums that address women's issues; a Counseling Center that will provide support and guidance to maintain mental health through substance abuse counseling, marriage counseling, grief counseling, youth counseling and mentoring programs; a Senior Citizen's Center will provide programs, activities, and opportunities for socialization to address the needs of the elderly; and a Health Center that will provide a venue for community access to health screenings, resources, information and referral services in collaboration with the Baltimore City Health Department and local hospitals.
