New Revival Center of Renewal specializes in providing housing and programmatic services for returning citizens, veterans and the homeless. NRCR provides emergency shelter, transitional and permanent housing for this clientele. When NRCR houses clients, they have an 80-85% success							

permanent housing for this clientele. When NRCR houses clients, they have an 80-85% success rate. this success is an immediate impact on crime and public safety. Prince George's County has no halfway houses or pre-release centers for returning citizens. NRCR has provided over20,000 bed nights of housing in 2011, and served over 5,000 clients. NRCR provides counseling, addiction services, case management, jobs readiness and is partnering with the Department. of Corrections, Parole and Probation, Social Services, Department of Health and community organizations.
