<p>The Perry Hall Athletic Boosters Club, Inc. is an all volunteer non-profit 501 c3 organization made up of parents and community members, whose goal is enrich the high school experience for current and future student athletes of Perry Hall High School and to provide needed supplemental support to the athletic programs.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The current condition of our athletic fields and facilities has led the Perry Hall High School Athletic Booster Club, Inc. to embark on a multi phased /multi-year Stadium and Athletic Facilities Enhancement or S.A.F.E. project, which will not only benefit the high school, but will benefit our local youth recreation programs as well as the local community. The initial phase of this project involves the replacement of our ailing scoreboard with a state of the art digital scoreboard at a cost of approximately \$110,000. Subsequent phases of the Stadium and Facilities Enhancement project will include the completion of a previous Baltimore County approved project to bring water to the Perry Hall High School stadium, as well of the installation of rest room facilities; the repositioning and upgrades of the lower field facilities providing handicapped access and lower field lighting; all of which will support football, soccer, track and field, lacrosse, baseball, field hockey, as well as other high school athletic and recreation council events.
