historic district. All design plans have been approved by the Historic District Commission, by the
Mayor and Council of the Town of Laytonsville, by the Montgomery County Department of
Permitting Services, and by the Maryland State Highway Administration. All necessary permits are
in hand for the commencement of construction activities. Item 13, page 2 and Item 15, page 3: The
mortgage loan of \$650,000 will be repaid in part from expected donations from the citizens and
businesses being served by the Laytonsville Volunteer District Fire Department. The fundraising
campaign is currently under way and funds and commitments anticipated to commence in the near
future.
