The Town of Riverdale Park was incorporated as a municipality in 1920. According to the 2010 census, the population density is 4218.3 people per square mile. The Town has approximately 7,000 residents, 27.7% of which are under the age of 18.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Town of Riverdale Park is in the process of renovating its Council Chambers in Town Hall to create a new Youth and Community wing. The additional 7,000 square feet of space would accommodate Town Council needs but would primarily be used for youth and community activities. Town Hall's proximity to Riverdale Elementary School offers an ideal after-school location. Space may be used for Riverdale Boys and Girls Club, local dance troupes, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, after-school programs, study groups, and learning centers.

The Youth and Community Wing project will increase the use at Town Hall from 50 people to approximately 400 people. Design has been completed, and the Town is now in the engineering phase.
