Senate Bill 128 (Senator Glassman, *et al.*) Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Economic Matters

Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Hours of Sale for Class B Licensees

This bill expands the hours for sale of beer and wine under a Class B Cafe license in Harford County by enabling a Class B Cafe licensee to sell alcoholic beverages between 8 a.m. and 2 a.m. the following day instead of between 10 a.m. and 11 p.m., Monday through Sunday, inclusive.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2013.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Harford County can monitor licenses with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal increase in revenue from the sale of beer and wine due to the expansion in hours for sale for holders of Class B Cafe licenses in Harford County.

Analysis

Current Law: The sale of beer and wine at Class B Cafe licensed locations in Harford County begins at 10 a.m. and extends through 11 p.m., Monday through Sunday, inclusive.

Background: The Harford County Liquor Control Board can issue a maximum of 5 Class B Cafe licenses.
