10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Prince George's Arts and Humanities Council is an independent non-profit organization designated by the Prince George's County government to coordinate financial support, provide integrated leadership and advocacy for the local arts and creative communities through grants, technical assistance, programs and value added partnerships among government, business, education, and community stakeholders. Our areas of focus are arts and economic development and arts and education. We are committed to providing artists with opportunities for artistic development, marketing and public presentation of their work. We offer workshops and professional development for art teachers and school administrators. PGAHC is also committed to support creative entrepreneurship and arts and cultural organizations from small, mid-size to large, emerging to established collectively to achieve their artistic, programmatic, educational, community, and operational goals. Ultimately, PGAHC seeks to be a catalyst in creating a world class cultural infrastructure where high quality arts and humanities programs and venues are readily accessible for all Prince George's County residents and visitors.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

PGAHC has become a county leader in arts centered economic development. The Creative Business Incubator (CBI) will be a much needed resource center for artists and local creative companies plus offer professional development, virtual business and mentoring programs to artists, arts educators and creative businesses operating outside of the incubator. Based on national best practices, CBI will expand the traditional arts incubator model to focus on job creation, sustainable marketing, technical assistance and business planning that moves ideas from conception to thriving creative businesses prepared to anchor Prince George's County's developing creative corridors and underserved communities. Arts incubators are a growing phenomena in the world of local arts agencies. They are facilities that create a nurturing environment for small and emerging arts organizations by offering low-cost or subsidized space and services. PGAHC has been located in its current operating space for over 15 years. At this time of continued growth, in capacity and service, PGAHC requires a larger operating space that is visible, accessible, more functional and centrally located within a creative corridor.

The Office of Central Services, supported by the Office of the County Executive, has granted
PGAHC in-kind space currently being re-constructed within the total renovation plans of the
existing County Service Building (CSB) in Hyattsville. The CSB was constructed somewhere
around 1956 (37,000 s.f.) and expanded to 69,000 s.f. around 1963, making the overall facility 50
and 60 years old. Recently Central Services initiated a project to perform critical restoration work
on the building, The basic scope of that work already awarded is \$ 729,473.
