(Senate Bill 175)

AN ACT concerning

State Government – Commemorative Days – Maryland Centenarians Day

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day as Maryland Centenarians Day; and generally relating to commemorative days.

BY adding to

Article – State Government

Section 13–411

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

13–411.

IN RECOGNITION OF THE LIVES OF THE STATE'S CITIZENS WHO HAVE REACHED THE LANDMARK AGE OF 100 YEARS, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE SECOND THURSDAY IN MAY AS MARYLAND CENTENARIANS DAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
