AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1127

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “altering” in line 5 down through “lien;” in line 6; in line 18, after “defining” insert “a”; in the same line, strike “terms” and substitute “term”; and in line 19, after “stylistic” insert “and clarifying”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 11, inclusive.

On page 2 in lines 12, 16, 18, 21, and 27 and on page 3 in lines 1 and 4, in each instance, strike the brackets.

On page 2, in lines 12, 16, 18, 21, and 27, strike “(D)”, “(E)”, “(F)”, “(G)”, and “(H)”, respectively.

On page 3, in lines 1 and 4, strike “(I)” and “(J)”, respectively; and in line 7, strike “(K)” and substitute “(J)”.

On page 4, in line 24, strike “(I)”; in line 27, strike “OR IN ANY OTHER COMMERCIALY REASONABLE MANNER”; and strike in their entirety lines 28 through 30, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 4, after “(2)” insert “(I)”; and after line 9, insert:

“(II) IF THE OPERATOR NOTIFIES THE OCCUPANT OF THE DEFAULT BY ELECTRONIC MAIL AT THE OCCUPANT’S LAST KNOWN ADDRESS AND DOES NOT RECEIVE A RESPONSE OR A CONFIRMATION OF DELIVERY SENT
