- (F) (1) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE A DEMONSTRATION OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY OF 8 EDUCATIONAL HOURS FOR A MASTER PLUMBER OR MASTER NATURAL GAS FITTER AS A CONDITION OF RENEWAL OF A MASTER PLUMBER OR MASTER NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPHS (2) THROUGH (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 11 (2) CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS 12 DO NOT APPLY TO THE FIRST RENEWAL OF A LICENSE.
- 13 (3) If a license expires on or before September 30, 2016, A

 21 LICENSEE IS REQUIRED TO FULFILL THE FULL CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL
 22 COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS AS PROVIDED IN THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY
 23 THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, prior to proposing regulations, the State Board of Plumbing shall convene a workgroup with interested stakeholders to act in an advisory capacity in the development of provisions regarding subject matter, approved providers, and other issues related to continuing professional competency.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2014.
