- FOR the purpose of requiring that all procurements by a designated procurement unit that fall within a certain dollar value range be designated for the Small Business Reserve program subject to a certain condition; and generally relating to the designation of certain procurements for the Small Business Reserve program.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) Any procurement by a designated procurement unit of goods, supplies, 19 services, maintenance, construction, construction—related services, architectural 20 services, and engineering services shall be eligible for designation for the small
- 21 business reserve.

1	(B) ANY PROCUREMENT BY A DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT WITH
2	AN EXPECTED VALUE OF \$15,000 TO \$100,000 SHALL BE DESIGNATED FOR THE
3	SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE UNLESS THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER, WITH THE
1	APPROVAL OF THE AGENCY HEAD OR DESIGNEE, MAKES A DETERMINATION
5	THAT THE PROCUREMENT SHOULD NOT BE DESIGNATED FOR THE SMALL
3	BUSINESS RESERVE.

- [(b)] (C) A solicitation for procurement that has been designated for a small business reserve shall be published in the same manner as required for an invitation for bids as set forth in § 13–103(c) of this article.
- 10 **[(c)] (D)** The procurement officer of a designated procurement unit shall award a procurement contract designated for a small business reserve to the small business that submits a responsive bid that:
- 13 (1) is the lowest bid price;
- 14 (2) if the invitation for bids so provides, is the lowest evaluated bid 15 price; or
- 16 (3) is the bid or proposal most favorable to the State within the small 17 business reserve.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
