# A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Criminal Law – Contraband – Telecommunication Devices and Accessories – 3 Penalty

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from attempting to deliver or possessing with  $\mathbf{5}$ the intent to deliver certain telecommunication devices or accessories to a 6 person detained or confined in a certain place of confinement; prohibiting a 7 person from depositing or concealing certain telecommunication devices or 8 accessories in or about a place of confinement; prohibiting a person detained or 9 confined in a place of confinement from knowingly possessing or receiving 10 certain telecommunication devices or accessories; increasing the penalty for 11 certain subsequent violations; requiring a certain sentence to be served consecutive to another sentence; and generally relating to the prohibition 12against telecommunication devices and accessories in a place of confinement. 13

#### HOUSE BILL 81

1 SUBSCRIBER IDENTIFICATION MODULE (SIM) CARD to a person detained or 2 confined in a place of confinement with signs posted indicating that such conduct is 3 prohibited.

4 (2) A person may not possess a telecommunication device, 5 **TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICE CHARGER, OR SIM CARD** with the intent to deliver 6 it to a person detained or confined in a place of confinement with signs posted 7 indicating that such conduct is prohibited.

8 (3) A person may not deposit or conceal a telecommunication device, 9 **TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICE CHARGER, OR SIM CARD** in or about a place of 10 confinement with signs posted indicating that such conduct is prohibited or on any 11 land appurtenant to the place of confinement with the intent that it be obtained by a 12 person detained or confined in the place of confinement.

(4) A person detained or confined in a place of confinement may not
 knowingly possess or receive a telecommunication device, TELECOMMUNICATION
 DEVICE CHARGER, OR SIM CARD.

16 (b) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 17 SUBSECTION, A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 18 conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding 19 \$1,000 or both.

(2) A PERSON WHO COMMITS A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT
 VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND
 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A
 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.

(C) A SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A)(4) OF
THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSECUTIVE TO ANY SENTENCE THAT THE PERSON
WAS SERVING AT THE TIME OF THE CRIME OR THAT HAD BEEN IMPOSED BUT
WAS NOT YET BEING SERVED AT THE TIME OF SENTENCING.
