  equitable ticket buying process; providing that a violation of this Act is an
  unfair or deceptive trade practice under the Maryland Consumer Protection Act
  and is subject to certain enforcement and penalty provisions; defining certain
  terms; and generally relating to ticket sales on the Internet.
