- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Budget and Management, rather than a certain unit of State government or a certain State officer, to submit certain information regarding certain capital projects to the General Assembly under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the submission of information regarding capital projects to the General Assembly.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article – State Finance and Procurement

- 16 3–602.
- 17 (f) (1) This subsection applies only to capital projects that involve construction of permanent or long–time duration.
- 19 (2) When the request for an appropriation for a capital project is 20 submitted to the General Assembly, the [unit of the State government that would 21 receive the capital project or a State officer on behalf of the unit] **DEPARTMENT** shall 22 submit to the General Assembly:



$\frac{1}{2}$	(i) preliminary plans and outline specifications for the project that show the size, the type of construction, and the arrangement of each building; and
3 4	(ii) a statement on the sufficiency of the proposed appropriation to pay fully for the costs of that project.
5 6	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
