## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Budget and Management – Budget Analysts – Qualifications**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law governing the experience,  
4 education, and other qualifications for individuals appointed as budget analysts  
5 by the Secretary of Budget and Management; and generally relating to budget  
6 analysts for the Department of Budget and Management.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article – State Finance and Procurement  
9 Section 3–203(b)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

15 3–203.

16 (b) (1) The Secretary shall appoint 1 or more budget analysts.

17 (2) [Each budget analyst must:

18 (i) have at least 3 years' experience in personnel and other  
19 subjects that are related to the operation of a business organization;

1                   (ii) be a graduate of a recognized school of business  
2 administration or have the additional experience that the Secretary requires; and

3                   (iii) meet any other qualifications that the Secretary sets.

4                   (3)] The budget analysts shall:

5                   (i) continually conduct studies of all budget expenditures of  
6 units of the Executive Branch of the State government;

7                   (ii) make recommendations to the Secretary for greater  
8 efficiency and economy in those units; and

9                   (iii) perform any other duties that the Secretary assigns.

10           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 July 1, 2014.
