

A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Task Force to Study Firearms and Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Devices

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Firearms and Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Devices; providing for the composition, chair, and 4 5 staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from 6 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 7 expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations 8 regarding certain issues relating to firearms and GPS devices; requiring the 9 Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of 10 this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Firearms and Global 11 12Positioning Satellite (GPS) Devices.
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Firearms and Global Positioning Satellite 16 (GPS) Devices.
- 17 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 19 President of the Senate;
- 20 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 21 of the House;
- 22 (3) the Secretary of State Police, or the Secretary's designee;
- 23 (4) the Attorney General, or the Attorney General's designee;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2014. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2015, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
