## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Barbershops – Restriction on Operation Repealed**

3 **MC 1–14**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain restriction prohibiting a barbershop in  
5 Montgomery County from being open for business more than a certain number  
6 of days per week; and generally relating to barbershops in Montgomery County.

7 BY repealing

8 Article – Business Occupations and Professions

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

15 [4–606.

16 A barbershop in Montgomery County may not open for business more than 6  
17 days a week.]

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 October 1, 2014.
