12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

15 [4–606.

16 A barbershop in Montgomery County may not open for business more than 6
17 days a week.]
