### Montgomery County – Alcoholic Beverages – Special BWL Community Performing Arts Facility License

#### MC 7-14

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of establishing a Special BWL Community Performing Arts Facility 6 alcoholic beverages license in Montgomery County; authorizing the Montgomery 7County Board of License Commissioners to issue a Special BWL Community 8 Performing Arts Facility license to apply to a certain performing arts facility; 9 authorizing the Board to issue the license to certain entities to host certain 10 activities; authorizing the Board to impose certain conditions on the issuance or 11 renewal of the license; prohibiting the Board from approving the transfer of the 12license to another location; authorizing holders of certain catering licenses to 13 bring alcohol and food onto certain licensed premises under the terms of a certain contract; providing that certain violations of alcoholic beverages law 14 apply to a certain caterer under certain circumstances; requiring a holder of the 15license to ensure that food is provided during a certain time; prohibiting the 16 17Board from issuing more than a certain number of licenses under this Act to a 18 certain entity; establishing a certain license fee; defining a certain term; and 19generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Montgomery County.

18 19 20 21	(5) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "COMMUNITY PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY" MEANS A FACILITY THAT IS USED FOR SHOWS, LIVE PERFORMANCES, THEATER PRODUCTIONS, ART CLASSES, EXHIBITS, VISUAL ART SHOWS, WEDDINGS, BANQUETS, AND COMMUNITY-RELATED ACTIVITIES.

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1 (V) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL 1.  $\mathbf{2}$ BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BY THE DRINK FROM ONE OR MORE OUTLETS ON THE 3 LICENSED PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES. 4 2. A HOLDER OF THE LICENSE MAY EXERCISE THE  $\mathbf{5}$ PRIVILEGES UNDER THE LICENSE FROM 10 A.M. ON ANY DAY UNTIL 2 A.M. THE 6 FOLLOWING DAY. 7 (VI) THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE CONDITIONS ON THE 8 ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE THAT ESTABLISH THE AREAS IN THE 9 COMMUNITY PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY WHERE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 10 MAY BE SOLD, SERVED, POSSESSED, OR CONSUMED. (VII) THE BOARD MAY NOT APPROVE THE TRANSFER OF THE 11 12LICENSE TO ANOTHER LOCATION. A HOLDER OF A CLASS B-BWLHR LICENSE WITH 13 (VIII) 1. CATERING AUTHORITY, A MONTGOMERY COUNTY CATERING LICENSE (CAT), 14OR A STATEWIDE CATERER LICENSE (SCAT) MAY BRING ALCOHOL AND FOOD 15ON THE LICENSED PREMISES UNDER THE TERMS OF A CONTRACT WITH A 16 17HOLDER OF A SPECIAL BWL COMMUNITY PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY

18 LICENSE.

192. A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE THAT OCCURS20WHEN A CATERER BRINGS ALCOHOL ON LICENSED PREMISES AS PROVIDED21UNDER SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH IS THE RESPONSIBILITY22OF THE CATERER AND IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOLDER OF THE23LICENSE.

(IX) A HOLDER OF THE LICENSE SHALL ENSURE THAT FOOD
IS PROVIDED DURING THE HOURS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD, SERVED,
POSSESSED, OR CONSUMED.

27(x) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE NO MORE THAN THREE28LICENSES TO A NOT-FOR-PROFIT PARTNERSHIP, A LIMITED LIABILITY29COMPANY, A CORPORATION, OR ANY OTHER ENTITY THAT OWNS OR LEASES30PERFORMING ARTS FACILITIES IN SEPARATE LOCATIONS.

31 (XI) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$750.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 July 1, 2014.
