13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18	(f) (1) Employees of the Fund may be assigned to perform functions of the Company under a contract between the Fund and the Company.
