- 4 (a) (1) The Circuit Administrative Judge of the First Circuit may 5 establish a Truancy Reduction Pilot Program in one or more of the juvenile courts in 6 Dorchester County, Somerset County, Wicomico County, and Worcester County.
- 7 (2) The Circuit Administrative Judge of the Second Circuit may 8 establish a Truancy Reduction Pilot Program in the juvenile [court] COURTS in KENT 9 COUNTY AND Talbot County.
- 10 (3) The Circuit Administrative Judge of the Third Circuit may 11 establish a Truancy Reduction Pilot Program in the juvenile court in Harford County.
