## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Unauthorized Use of Rented Motor Vehicle – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law that prohibits a person who rents a  
4 motor vehicle under a certain agreement from permitting another person to  
5 drive the vehicle; repealing a provision of law specifying that if a person rents a  
6 motor vehicle under a certain agreement, no other person may drive the vehicle  
7 without the consent of the lessor or the agent of the lessor; repealing a certain  
8 penalty; and generally relating to the use of rented motor vehicles.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Transportation**

1 (a) If a person rents a motor vehicle under an agreement not to permit  
2 another person to drive the vehicle the person may not permit any other person to  
3 drive the rented motor vehicle.

4 (b) If a person rents a motor vehicle under an agreement not to permit  
5 another person to drive the vehicle no other person may drive the rented motor vehicle  
6 without the consent of the lessor or his agent.】

8 (c) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of the  
9 following sections of this article is subject to a fine of not more than \$500 or  
10 imprisonment for not more than 2 months or both:

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2014.
