## Health Occupations - Physicians - Payments for Office Visits

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a licensed physician from presenting or causing to be presented a claim, bill, or demand for payment for an office visit if the physician did not commence treatment within a certain amount of time; establishing a certain exception to the prohibition; authorizing a licensed physician to present or cause to be presented a claim, bill, or demand for payment for a procedure performed during a certain office visit; and generally relating to payments to licensed physicians for office visits.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article – Health Occupations

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- 19 (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 20 SECTION, A LICENSED PHYSICIAN MAY NOT PRESENT, OR CAUSE TO BE
- 21 PRESENTED, A CLAIM, BILL, OR DEMAND FOR PAYMENT FOR AN OFFICE VISIT IF
- 22 THE PHYSICIAN DID NOT COMMENCE TREATMENT WITHIN 30 MINUTES AFTER
- 23 THE TIME SCHEDULED FOR THE OFFICE VISIT.



1	(B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
2	SECTION, A LICENSED PHYSICIAN MAY PRESENT OR CAUSE TO BE PRESENTED A
3	CLAIM, BILL, OR DEMAND FOR PAYMENT FOR A PROCEDURE PERFORMED
4	DURING AN OFFICE VISIT AT WHICH THE PHYSICIAN DID NOT COMMENCE
5	TREATMENT WITHIN 30 MINUTES AFTER THE TIME SCHEDULED FOR THE
6	OFFICE VISIT.

- 7 (C) A LICENSED PHYSICIAN MAY PRESENT OR CAUSE TO BE PRESENTED 8 A CLAIM, BILL, OR DEMAND FOR PAYMENT FOR AN OFFICE VISIT:
- 9 (1) If the licensed physician is unable to commence 10 Treatment within 30 minutes after the time scheduled for the 11 Office visit due to an emergency; and
- 12 **(2)** THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN PROVIDES THE PATIENT WITH AN 13 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES VERIFICATION NUMBER FOR THE EMERGENCY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
