CHAPTER

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2 Transportation – Metropolitan Planning Organizations – Notice and Public Hearing

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation to give certain notice to certain members of the General Assembly before beginning the process of establishing, altering, or eliminating a Metropolitan Planning Organization for transportation planning purposes for certain areas in the State; requiring the Department to hold a public hearing within a certain area of the State to address the establishment, alteration, or elimination of a Metropolitan Planning Organization if any of certain members of the General Assembly requests the public hearing within a certain time period; and generally relating to notice and public hearings with respect to the establishment, alteration, or elimination of a Metropolitan Planning Organization.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

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- 5 (e) (1) The Secretary is responsible for all planning activities of the 6 Department and for the development and maintenance of a continuing, comprehensive, and integrated transportation planning process.
- 8 (2) In accordance with § 2–103.1 of this subtitle, the Secretary shall 9 develop and, with the approval of the Governor, shall adopt a State Report on 10 Transportation to guide program development and to foster efficient and economical 11 transportation services throughout the State.
- 12 (3) On or before the 3rd Wednesday of January of each year, the 13 Secretary shall submit the State Report on Transportation to the General Assembly, 14 subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article.
- 15 (E-1) (1) BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT BEGINS THE PROCESS OF
 16 ESTABLISHING, ALTERING, OR ELIMINATING A METROPOLITAN PLANNING
 17 ORGANIZATION FOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNING PURPOSES FOR AN AREA IN
 18 THE STATE DESIGNATED UNDER FEDERAL LAW AS AN URBANIZED AREA, THE
 19 DEPARTMENT SHALL GIVE NOTICE OF THE PENDING PROCESS BY CERTIFIED
 20 MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, TO EACH MEMBER OF THE GENERAL
 21 ASSEMBLY REPRESENTING:
- 22 (I) A STATE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT, ANY PORTION OF 23 WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE URBANIZED AREA; AND
- 24 (II) A STATE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT THAT IS LOCATED 25 WITHIN 1 MILE OF THE BORDER OF THE URBANIZED AREA.
- 26 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN THE
 27 DESIGNATED URBANIZED AREA TO ADDRESS ISSUES RELATED TO THE
 28 ESTABLISHMENT, ALTERATION, OR ELIMINATION OF A METROPOLITAN
 29 PLANNING ORGANIZATION IF A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHO IS
 30 PROVIDED NOTICE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION REQUESTS THE
 31 PUBLIC HEARING WITHIN 45 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 October 1, 2014.
