## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Education – Training Video on Cardiopulmonary**  
3 **Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillators**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to post a training video on  
5 hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external  
6 defibrillators on its Web site; requiring the training video to be ~~obtained~~  
7 selected by the State Board, in collaboration with the Department of Health and  
8 Mental Hygiene, at no charge, if possible, and to be no more than a certain  
9 number of minutes in duration; requiring each county board of education to post  
10 a link to the training video on the school system Web site, to publicize the  
11 training video in a certain manner ~~and~~, and to encourage certain individuals to  
12 view the training video; and generally relating to the posting of a training video  
13 on hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external  
14 defibrillators on the State Board of Education Web site.
