6	(II) FREDERICK COUNTY.
7 8 9	(b) On or before July 1, 2013, a county or municipality shall adopt and implement local laws or ordinances necessary to establish a watershed protection and restoration program.
10 11	(c) A watershed protection and restoration program established under this section shall include:
12	(1) A stormwater remediation fee; and
13	(2) A local watershed protection and restoration fund.
14 15	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
