- 3 (II) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER POSITION ON THE 4 COUNCIL SHALL BE APPOINTED BY:
- 5 1. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 6 CALVERT COUNTY IN 2014, AND EACH THIRD YEAR THEREAFTER;
- 7 2. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 8 CHARLES COUNTY IN 2015, AND EACH THIRD YEAR THEREAFTER; AND
- 9 3. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. 10 MARY'S COUNTY IN 2016, AND EACH THIRD YEAR THEREAFTER.
- 11 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor 12 is appointed.
- 13 (4) [Except for an ex officio member, a] A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed.
