## Education – School Vehicles – Authorized Riders

16 (a) An individual may not drive a school vehicle on any highway in this State 17 unless the individual:

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS **(B)** SECTION, A DRIVER OF A SCHOOL VEHICLE MAY NOT ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT A STUDENT OR SCHOOL EMPLOYEE TO BOARD OR RIDE ON THE SCHOOL VEHICLE. **(C)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BOARD AND RIDE ON A SCHOOL VEHICLE AS A SCHOOL VEHICLE ATTENDANT IF THE INDIVIDUAL: (1) **(I)** IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM OR TRANSPORTATION COMPANY THAT OPERATES THE SCHOOL VEHICLE; IS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL **(II)** SYSTEM TO ACT AS A SCHOOL VEHICLE ATTENDANT FOR A CHILD ON THE SCHOOL VEHICLE; OR (III) IS A NURSE, AN AIDE, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL ASSIGNED OR AUTHORIZED TO WORK WITH A STUDENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLAN, 504 PLAN, OR OTHER STUDENT-SPECIFIC WRITTEN PLAN; AND (2) IS IN POSSESSION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION THAT **(I) IDENTIFIES THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM OR TRANSPORTATION COMPANY THAT** EMPLOYS THE INDIVIDUAL AS A SCHOOL VEHICLE ATTENDANT; OR IS IN POSSESSION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION OR **(II)** ANOTHER DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT AUTHORIZES THE INDIVIDUAL TO ACT AS A SCHOOL VEHICLE ATTENDANT FOR A CHILD ON THE SCHOOL VEHICLE. **(**D**)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BOARD AND RIDE ON A SCHOOL VEHICLE WITH THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM. With the advice of the State Department of Education, the [(b)] **(E)** Administration may adopt regulations concerning the qualifications of school vehicle drivers.
