## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011 – Baltimore City – In Our**  
3 **House Homeless Youth Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011  
5 to repeal a requirement that a certain grantee provide a matching fund;  
6 specifying the amounts of certain grants; providing that certain grants may not  
7 terminate before a certain date; and generally relating to amending the  
8 Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Chapter 396 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011  
11 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(P) and Item ZA03(R)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
