- 3 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 4 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT
- 5 EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2014.
