Alcoholic Beverages – Farmers' Market Permit – Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a farmers' market permit; authorizing the Office of 4 the Comptroller to issue the permit to a holder of a certain license under certain 5 circumstances; requiring the permit holder to provide certain notice to the local 6 licensing board of a certain jurisdiction; specifying the places and times in 7 which a permit holder may use a farmers' market permit; prohibiting the Office 8 of the Comptroller from issuing more than a certain number of permits for use 9 at each farmers' market; authorizing a permit holder to take certain actions in connection with the farmers' market permit; requiring that all wine offered for 10 11 sale or sampling by the permit holder be the product of a certain class of winery; 12 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the sale and sampling of 13 alcoholic beverages at farmers' markets.
