A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Services – Transfers of Inmates – Information**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that, if an inmate is transferred from one correctional
4 facility to another correctional facility, the transferring facility shall send
5 certain information as part of the transfer; and generally relating to transfers of
6 inmates.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Correctional Services**

15 **9–309.**

16 **IF AN INMATE IS TRANSFERRED FROM ONE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO**
17 **ANOTHER CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, THE TRANSFERRING FACILITY SHALL SEND**
18 **AS PART OF THE TRANSFER:**

19 **(1) A NOTIFICATION REGARDING THE TRANSFER TO THE COURT**
20 **ORDERING THE COMMITMENT OF THE INMATE AND TO THE STATE’S**
21 **ATTORNEY’S OFFICE THAT PROSECUTED THE INMATE;**

22 **(2) THE COMMITMENT RECORD OF THE INMATE, INCLUDING**
23 **RESTITUTION INFORMATION UNDER MARYLAND RULE 4–351(A)(6);**

2 **THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE; AND**

3 **(4) THE SENTENCING GUIDELINES WORKSHEET UNDER §**
4 **6-216(C) OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2014.
