Baltimore City – Law Enforcement Officers – Video Cameras

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain law enforcement officer in Baltimore City to 4 wear a video camera affixed to the law enforcement officer's uniform while on $\mathbf{5}$ duty; requiring that any interaction between the law enforcement officer and a 6 member of the public be recorded; prohibiting a video camera from making an 7 audio recording; requiring that a recording be preserved by the Baltimore Police 8 Department for a certain period of time; requiring the Baltimore Police 9 Department to develop certain policies and procedures; providing that this Act does not apply to a law enforcement officer who is on detective duty; defining 10 certain terms; and generally relating to law enforcement officers in Baltimore 11 12City.
