1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland Transit Administration - Pretax Commuter Benefits Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transit Administration to include as part 4 of a plan to meet certain transit needs improvements to its fare payment 5 systems; specifying that the plan allow the Administration to process fare media 6 in electronic form and provide electronic fare media to employers for 7 distribution to employees; requiring the Administration to implement certain 8 fare payment systems in a manner that allows employees to enroll in a 9 commuter benefits program online and use certain pretax contributions to pay for the electronic fare media; and generally relating to electronic fare payment 10 systems for transit services and the employee pretax commuter benefits 11 12program.
