A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt – Baltimore City – Greenmount Construction Jobs 3 Training Center

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of 4 $\mathbf{5}$ \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the 6 People's Homesteading Group, Incorporated for certain development or 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject 8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; 9 establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds: and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing 10 the loan. 11

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:

14 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore 16 City – Greenmount Construction Jobs Training Center Loan of 2014 in the total 17 principal amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and 18 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of 19 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8–117 through 20 8–124 and 8–131.2 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold 22 as a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds 23 under § 8–122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

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Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the People's Homesteading Group, Incorporated (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Greenmount Construction Jobs Training Center, located in Baltimore City.

7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

11 Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the (5)purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 1213matching fund of \$100,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 1415unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of funds expended prior to the 16 effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property or in kind 17contributions. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall 1819determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 202016, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching 21fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this 22fact to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the 23purposes provided in this Act.

(6) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board
of Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2021. If any
funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1, 2021,
the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be canceled and
be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the amount of
unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as provided in
§ 8–129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 32 June 1, 2014.

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
