- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Investigate the Treatment of 4 Lender-Owned Properties; providing for the composition, cochairs, and staffing 5 of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from receiving 6 certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 7 requiring the Commission to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Commission to report its findings and 8 9 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to 10 the Commission to Investigate the Treatment of Lender-Owned Properties. 11
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) There is a Commission to Investigate the Treatment of Lender-Owned 15 Properties.
- 16 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 17 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President 18 of the Senate;
- 19 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 20 the House;
- 21 (3) the Secretary of Housing and Community Development, or the 22 Secretary's designee;
- 23 (4) the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation, or the 24 Secretary's designee;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
