- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a
  person to hunt deer on private property on certain Sundays in Calvert County,
  subject to certain provisions of law; and generally relating to the regulation of
  deer hunting by the Department of Natural Resources.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Natural Resources

16 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (6), and (7) of this 17 subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays.

18 (2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and 19 mammals on Sundays:
