4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Unaccompanied Homeless Youth and $\mathbf{5}$ Young Adult Count Demonstration Project; requiring the Department of 6 Planning Housing and Community Development to select and monitor a 7 coordinating entity to oversee the Maryland Unaccompanied Homeless Youth 8 and Young Adult Count Demonstration Project; establishing the purpose of the 9 Project; requiring the coordinating entity to be selected through a competitive 10 request for proposal or by sole source contract; requiring the coordinating entity 11 to determine the number and characteristics of unaccompanied homeless youth 12and young adults in certain jurisdictions Continuums of Care using certain 13 methods; requiring the coordinating entity to assign each youth participant a 14unique identifier; requiring the Department of Planning to provide certain 15technical assistance; requiring the **Department** Departments to make every 16 effort to identify non-State sources of funding to fund the cost of the Project; providing for the termination of this Act; requiring the coordinating entity to 1718 submit a certain report on or before a certain date; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to the Unaccompanied Maryland 19 20Homeless Youth and Young Adult Count Demonstration Project.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That:

3 (a) The Department of Planning shall select a coordinating entity to oversee 4 the There is a Maryland Unaccompanied Homeless Youth and Young Adult Count 5 Demonstration Project.

1 (5) Data collection conducted under this subsection shall be conducted 2 to coincide with the end of the K-12 school year and the reporting of data under the 3 federal McKinney–Vento Homeless Assistance Act.

4 (6) To protect the anonymity of youth participants <u>and avoid</u> 5 <u>duplication</u>, the coordinating entity shall assign each youth participant a unique 6 identifier that does not reveal the participant's identity.

<u>The Department of Planning shall:</u>

- 8 (1) assist with presurvey data collection consultation and mapping 9 support;
- 10 (2) <u>analyze and compile data after the survey is completed; and</u>
- 11 (3) provide a technical review of draft reports.

12 (f) (g) The Department Departments shall make every effort to identify 13 non–State sources of funding to fund the cost of the Project, including:

- 14 (1) applying for federal or university grants; and
- 15 (2) partnering with private entities to share the cost.

(h) On or before September 30, 2017, the coordinating entity shall submit a
report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government
Article, on the results of the Project.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is contingent on 1920the receipt of funding from non-State sources to select a coordinating entity to oversee 21the Maryland Unaccompanied Homeless Youth and Young Adult Count 22Demonstration Project. The Department of Housing and Community Development 23shall notify the Department of Legislative Services within 5 days after funding is received. If notice of the receipt of funding is not received by the Department of 24Legislative Services on or before June 30, 2018, this Act shall be null and void without 2526the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

27 <u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions</u> 28 <u>of Section 2 of this Act, this Act</u> shall take effect October July 1, 2014. It shall remain 29 <u>effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2017, with no further</u> 30 <u>action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further</u> 31 <u>force and effect.</u>

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
