State Board of Physicians – Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Nuclear Medicine Technologists – Requirements for Licensing

- FOR the purpose of requiring that certain applicants for licensure as radiographers, 4 5 radiation therapists, and nuclear medicine technologists graduate from certain 6 education programs accredited by certain national accrediting bodies and hold 7 certain licensure, submit verification of certain employment, and not have been 8 subject to or have pending certain disciplinary action under certain 9 circumstances; requiring that certain applicants for licensure as radiographers, radiation therapists, and nuclear medicine technologists have passed certain 10 examinations, have been certified and maintain certain registration or 11 12 certification, and meet certain education, training, or examination requirements 13 established by the Board; and generally relating to the State Board of radiographers, radiation therapists, and nuclear Physicians, 14 technologists and requirements for licensing. 15
